- All students arrive wearing their first class costume and shoes. These costumes will be distributed this week. You will only receive one costume at distribution time. If your child is in multiple pieces those costumes will be handled by WMAAC backstage.

Check in-Please check child in with NO street shoes, jackets, toys, bags, etc. parents are **not** allowed backstage.

Check out-Performers will be checked out immediately following their turn on stage.

Children will leave in the costume they arrived in.

Performance Day Sunday, May 21st

Call times

- **Student in pieces 1-10 12:15pm** (See order above)
- **Student in pieces 10-21 12:30pm**

Arrive with costumes on, dance shoes on, hair pulled back and no accessories. There is no room to change your child, they must come dressed in costume.

Performance begins at 1pm SHARP

- Children must arrive in complete costume **including dance shoes.**
- **There is NO space for changing,** parents are **not** allowed backstage.
- We will have all hairpieces backstage.
- Hair must be pulled up and secured out of your child's face. Children cannot be checked in until hair is complete.

Check in

Please check your child in with NO street shoes, jackets, toys, bags, food, water etc. **in FULL costume.**

Check out

Pieces 2-9 will be checked out after piece 9 performs.

2-4 will be dismissed from check in desk in hallway. 5-9 will be dismissed from the stage.

Tickets:

Tickets will be in an envelope which you will receive attached to your child's costume bag.

All those entering the theater must have a WMAAC ticket wristband on for performance day.

Tickets CANNOT be purchased at the theater. Contact us TODAY if you need extra (you will receive two).

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Photography/Filming:

No flash photography, this is very distracting to the performers on stage. Video and photographs may be taken, we ask for all families to please use discretion when posting on public sites to protect the privacy of our students. Theater Etiquette:

Our faculty works hard to educate the students on how to behave in a professional and respectful manner. If the parents and theatergoers also practice courtesy, our young artists will learn from that. It is important to be quiet in the audience and backstage areas. We ask that you move in and out of the theater during applause BETWEEN numbers only. It is very distracting to the audience and performers when people are moving around during the show. Please do not yell children's names while performing, or approach stage during the performances.

Performance Day is a great occasion for your child to feel proud of their accomplishments and celebrate what they know! Your enjoyment, the student's safety and happiness are our primary concerns.

- **My child is in multiple classes but I have only received one costume**

You will only receive your child's first performing costume. We have all others back stage.

- **I haven't received my tickets. When will I get them?**

You will receive your envelope of ticket wrist bands attached to your child's costume bag.

- **Can I purchase tickets at the theater?**

No. Please contact us by THE END OF OUR BUSINESS DAY,(6:30 PM) Thursday, May 18th, 2017.

- **Does my child's sibling need a ticket?**

If they will be sitting in their own seat yes. Children young enough to sit on a lap will not be required to have a ticket.

- **What should my child wear?**

Please send your child in their costume with dance shoes. Please do not put them in their performance tight for dress rehearsal.

- **When will I receive my child's costume?**

You will receive your child's first performing costume one week prior to dress rehearsal.

- **Can I take my child's costume home?**

Yes, the cost of your costume was included in your tuition.

- **I purchased additional but they are not in the envelope.**

They may have been left out by mistake. Email us or inform us at check in.

- **I'm worried my child will be upset without me backstage with them.**

We do not allow parents backstage in order to insure the safety of all students, there are no exceptions. We will make sure your child is well taken care of and made to feel safe.
